Purple Woods Conservation Area, the site of Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority's annual Purple Woods Maple Syrup Festival in Spring, is a 17-hectare, sugar maple forest and open meadow located amidst the provincially significant Oak Ridges Moraine. Enjoy the southern view all the way to Lake Ontario from Heritage Hall. A 0.5-km trail allows for a quick stroll down the hollow.

This is where you will find the sugar shack, the heart of this operating sugarbush. Visit in Spring and discover how maple production has changed from local Indigenous technology to our modern method used today.
