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Limitations:

1. Scholarship award must be applied toward costs at an accredited **4-year** college or university for the immediate ensuing school term.
2. Scholarship funds will be awarded in two (2) installments: (a) first installment (**\$5,000.00**) is awarded **no earlier than** November 2026 (b) 2nd and remaining installment (**\$5,000.00**) is awarded **no earlier than** August 2027 [in the 2nd collegiate year and student is in good standing].
3. Scholarship is awarded directly to the student after official documentation is received. Official document is (a) Letter of Verification from the college/university, or (b) an unofficial fall 2026 transcript, listing courses and units.
4. Your name and date on all pages of your application.
5. Scholarship selectees will be notified by Friday, May 8, 2026.

Basic selection:

1. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Only school year 2025-26 application forms will be accepted.
3. Scholarship will be awarded based on the student's (a) college plans, academic achievement, school record and (b) the 500-word double spaced essay, with information regarding leadership positions and skills, extracurricular activities, volunteer, and work experiences.
4. Financial needs. Include all other information, personal or otherwise, that you think would be helpful in determining your financial needs. Please include any and all scholarships received.
