Contact information

- name
- email address
- telephone number
- organisation name

Communication information

- information provided in emails or contact forms
- records of communications relating to enquiries or services

Technical information

- IP address
- browser type and device information
- basic analytics relating to website use

We do not intentionally collect special category personal data through the website.

3. How We Use Personal Data

We process personal data for the following purposes:

- responding to enquiries
- communicating regarding services
- arranging meetings or consultations
- providing governance assessment services
- improving our website and services
- maintaining business records

Where required, processing is based on:

- legitimate interests in operating our business
- consent where applicable

- contractual necessity where services are provided.

4. Data Sharing

All such parties are required to maintain appropriate confidentiality and security protections.

5. Data Retention
