

# Medicaid and Children's Services Program Benefits Overview

When you start the enrollment process, you may find that the child in your care could be eligible for a few different programs. This overview can help you understand the benefits of each program. It has information about Wisconsin Medicaid (Katie Beckett, BadgerCare Plus), the Children's Long-Term Support (CLTS) Waiver Program, and the Children's Community Options Program (CCOP). The child can be enrolled in one or more of these programs depending on your family's needs.
