Here are some last minute thoughts and reminders to help you finalize your preparations.

- Check-in begins at noon on Saturday. We will close registration at 4. If you are delayed, give us a call at 928-853-0256 and we will make arrangements to meet you later to get you checked in.

- Dinner is at 5:30 on Saturday evening, there is a snack bar but you may want to eat in Williams before heading to camp.
- There are NO bikes, scooters or skateboards allowed at camp. Please leave these items at home.
- Lost Canyon policy is that no alcohol is allowed on property.
- Camp has enforced a weight minimum/ maximum on the rides needing a harness. The minimum to be able to ride the zipline, swing or climbing wall is 60 pounds and the harness needs to fit properly.
- And finally, no pets allowed on property so leave your dog, guinea pig and pet mice at home please!

Direction to Lost Canyon:

**From I17 north, the exit to get on the I40 is closed and a detour leads you east to Butler where you may reenter the freeway on 40 west.

From I-40, take Exit #163 to Grand Canyon Blvd. Follow GC Blvd. south to the 2nd stop sign. Turn right onto Railroad Ave. Continue for 2 blocks and turn left onto 4th St. Follow 4th St. south out of town. 4th St. becomes Perkinsville Rd. Take this road a total of 1.9 miles (past the reservoir) until you see the left turn lane and a green “Lost Canyon” road sign. Turn left onto the camp road and drive to the parking area near the gate and main office.
