1. What we collect and why

RemovAid AS controls processes (such as feedback and complaint) that can collect personal data. We collect this data to improve the safety and performance of our products and services. We do not sell your data and do not intend to transfer it outside EU.

a. Identity & contact information

3. How we secure your data

Data you share with us is uploaded into our electronic Quality Management System using the Egnyte online platform. Documents are stored in n+2 (with n+3 option) RAID 6 storage across two SAS 70 compliant data centers (3 copies maintained at all time). Egnyte achieves end-to-end security with role-based delegation and the ability to set protections at every step of the collaboration workflow: user, content, device, transport and storage. Retention durations are defined in RemovAid's document procedures. RemovAid also has implemented organizational security measures internally.
