- Your plan to achieve those goals and the timeline related to the accomplishment of those goals

It must be typed and double spaced.

Applicants must complete 2 hours of community service hours by September 15, 2025.

Submit 1 letter of verification to support your community service hours.

Be submitted to the Youth and Young Adult Department and postmarked no later than September 15, 2025.
