TeleVet is a locally owned violence diversion & mental wellness center that provides therapy, medication, peer support, educational resources, & socioeconomic assistance, such as food, housing, childcare, and transportation support for victims of violence. We work with the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children, the Mississippi Division of Medicaid, & youth courts.
