



A Benevolent Organization Serving The Manalapan Community

1967:

Families from the Yorktowne Development Organized a social club on an informal basis to essentially coordinate athletics & social activities for the benefit of its members & their families.

Meetings were held monthly on the third Friday of each month at various taverns and clubs in Manalapan. Dues at that time were \$1.00 per month.

The membership grew rapidly to 70 family's ad the club was officially incorporated in November 1967 as the Yorktowne Social Club Inc, a nonprofit organization. The club members played a very active role in working with and supporting various athletic activities such as Little League Baseball, Manalapan Football, Soccer & Basketball leagues. Members also held office in all these organizations in addition to coaching & officiating duties.

1975:

The club purchased Rosella's Tavern and the building was completely renovated by club members and has been our home ever since. Through the years, club members have worked to renovate, repair, and add to the building to meet the club's needs and member's comfort.

1997-2002:

The club paid off its original mortgage as well as all the building improvement bonds that were issued to former & current members

2001-2002:

The club was completely refurbished and a large outside deck was added to the rear of the building. These improvements further enabled us to provide opportunities to host additional club functions. Membership grew to 130 members and dues are \$125 per year.

2021:

The Yorktowne Club, with great effort from membership, held the most successful event in club history, a golf outing to raise money and awareness for the National Breast Cancer Foundation. We were proud to donate \$35,000 to this great cause.

The Yorktowne Club has been very instrumental in many charitable activities over the years including Blood Drives, Christmas & Easter food baskets, Heart Fund, and purchasing a Kidney Dialysis machine. As part of our responsibilities, club members have participated in

fund drives for local EMS, CentraState Hospital, Manalapan EMS, as well as raising \$7,000 towards the purchase of bullet proof vests for the Manalapan Police Department.

We continue to be a strong supporter of the Samaritan Center, a local food bank in Englishtown. On September 14, 2002, the club supported the inaugural Walk With Joe 9/11 Memorial Walk in honor of Patrick "Joe" Driscoll, a club member we lost on flight 93 on September 11, 2001. To date the club has raised over \$200,000 for various charities and causes.
