


'All Things Dogs' Dog Show

Our classes hope to inspire you to have your dog healthy and comfortable in their moment. The classes will be judged by qualified professional veterinary physiotherapist, Lily Moffatt.

Winners will receive a rosette and the ultimate goody bag to take home.

There will also be prizes for 2nd and 3rd place.

The dog show is designed to be FUN but also informative. We aim to make sure our categories are slightly different to the normal ones and hope you will take something away from our classes, whether this be a new game or trick for your dog to practice, or whether it be something to work on and improve such as your dogs walk or musculature.


Classes will be £1 with a donation from all classes going towards East Midlands Dog Resuce.

Class 1: Sassiest Stature: Dog with the best stand

This class aims to highlight the imporance of your dogs posture and identifying where they may differ from a 'normal' stand. The dog with the best stand will be picked based on the criteria below.

What is a good stand?

- •Front paws underneath shoulders (line A)
- •Hocks perpendicular to the ground (line B)
- •Head straight with eyes looking forward (line C)
- •Both front and hind paws placed evenly (not staggered) with weight evenly distributed among all four limbs (line D)
- •Topline is flat and appropriate for breed standard (line E)
- •Elbows close to the body and not pointing outward (line F)



Class 2. Best mutt strut: Dog with the best walk

In this class we will pick the dog who is walking with the best free movement.

A walk is the slowest pattern and during a walk, there are always 3 paws on the ground to support the body. Each foot lifts from the ground one at a time in a regular sequence.

This class will be assessed on your dogs walk, we are looking for your dog to be:

- Moving freely without lameness
- Tracking up hind feet to front feet
- Able to move in a straight line
- No dragging of toes

Class 3. Strike a pose: Dog with the best trick

This class will be looking for your dog to perform the best trick, so get inventive with your ideas! We will be looking at the way your dog is performing their trick and assessing their movement as they do so.

Some ideas:

- Bow
- Circle through legs
- Beg
- Give paws







Class 4. Wobbliest dog: Dog who can complete our obstacle course in the best time and without faults.

The obstacle course will include:

- Wobble cushion
- Tunnel
- Block work
- Peanut ball
- Hoops

And more.....



We will time you from the start line and we will judge you based on your dogs confidence completing the tasks.... All will be explained more on the day. Class 5. Fabulous physique: Dog with the best muscle development for age and breed.

This class will be looking at your dogs overall muscle build up and development. The winner will have the most symmetric muscle development for their age and breed.

Your dog should be ok with the judge having a feel of their muscle tone in this class.

You will be asked to stand your dog in the centre for an assessment.



Class 6. One of kind: The dog coping with the most interesting ailment such as 3 legged, one eye or on wheels. This will be judged on the dogs ability to move freely.

This class is for all dogs who are slightly different, perhaps they only have 3 legs, one eye, are on wheels or more!

We will ask you to briefly explain your dogs story and we will judge this class based on which dog is able to cope with their ailment in the best possible way.



Class 7. Terrific tenner: The class for the older dogs 10+

This class is for dogs aged 10 or older.

We will be looking for the best senior canine in the class who is most active and fit.

You will be asked to walk your dog around the ring and present the dog to the judge.





Class 8. Grand prix winner: Dog who can successfully complete our polework challenge

Our polework challenge will consist of a series of exercises performed with out poles. This will be knock out rounds! The dog who can complete all polework challenges is the winner.

Challenge 1- Walk over low raised poles without knocking them

Challenge 2- Trot over low raised poles without knocking them

Challenge 3- Figure of 8 pole without knocking Challenge 4 - Back up over a pole

Class 9. Find it, fetch it: Best retrieval of toy in our steady box challenge


You will be asked to retrieve a toy of ours or a toy of your own from our cardboard box challenge area.

You can encourage your dog with your voice for this exercise and you can use onr of our long lines for your dog to be allowed to explore.



Class 10. Double your distance: Dog who can do the best sit/down/stay from a distance.

Clip your dog up to one of our long lines and we will hold the end of the line. You will walk to the allotted area and command your dog to do a stay, sit and a lie down from where they are stood. This must be performed before they get to a cone marker.



- The charge for taking part in the Dog Show is £1 per class, per dog.
- Payment must be made at time of registration.
- Children under the age of 16 MUST be accompanied by an adult.
- Dogs must be over the age of 13 weeks to enter classes
- Participants may enter more than one class. It is the responsibility of the entrant to ensure that the class times entered do not clash.
- Unfortunately, given the limited number of spaces, all entry fees are non-refundable.
- All owners must clean up after their dog.
- Any specific information and instructions given by any stewards/officials must be adhered to and decisions of the judges are final.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel any classes or to move a participant to another similar class.
