

WINTER MAINTENANCE

Checklist:

- Monitor for ice dams and remove safely
- Keep paths and walkways clear of snow/ice
- Check insulation in attic and crawl spaces
- Inspect for drafts and seal gaps
- Keep vents clear (dryer, attic, etc.)
- Run ceiling fans in reverse (clockwise) to circulate warm air
- Maintain humidifiers
- Monitor sump pump operation
- Gather materials to wrap your pipes if needed.
