

## Covid-19 Policies

Connections: Speech and Language Therapy currently operates by providing individual, in-person speech therapy sessions within That Speech Bus, our mobile therapy suite. We want to assure our clients of our dedication to providing a safe and sanitary therapy space. To safeguard the health and wellbeing of our clients and staff, we have instituted the following precautions:

- ✦ That Speech Bus only allows for one (1) client per session.
- ✦ No client or visitor that has a fever and/or cough, is ill, or believes they have had symptoms of the Coronavirus or the flu in the last 14 days will be allowed entry into That Speech Bus
- ✦ Our Speech-Language Pathologists (SLPs) will wear a filtering mask ( $\geq 95\%$ ) and/or face shield throughout all therapy sessions.
  - In some instances, it is necessary for SLPs to briefly show their mouths, in order to model or demonstrate tasks; during such times, a face shield will be in place.
- ✦ Masks will be made available. Clients receiving therapy are not required to wear a mask but are welcome to wear one.
  - Any caregiver or authorized representative who joins a session is required to wear a mask
- ✦ All materials, equipment, and surfaces will be thoroughly disinfected between visits.
- ✦ Please wash your hands before entering That Speech Bus. Hand sanitizer will also be provided upon entry.
- ✦ If you or your loved one is sick, take a break from therapy and focus on getting well. We can reschedule!

We prioritize the health and safety of our clients, their families, and our providers. By instituting and abiding by these measures, we aim to minimize the transmission of illnesses and give our clients peace of mind.
