

QField Broome Fishing Area Map Instructions

The Broome Fishing Area Map allows anglers to determine their grid square location by using a smartphone app to aid in recording their catches.

Once imported, the map is available for offline use. You also do not need to set up an account to use the map.



You can install the free **QField for QGIS** mobile app from the [Apple App Store](https://apps.apple.com/au/app/qfield-for-qgis/id1531726814) for IOS or from the [Google Play Store](https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=ch.opengis.qfield&pcampaignid=web_share) for Android.

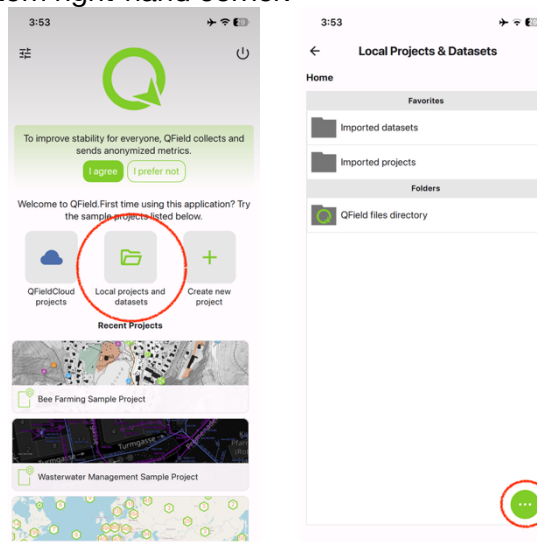

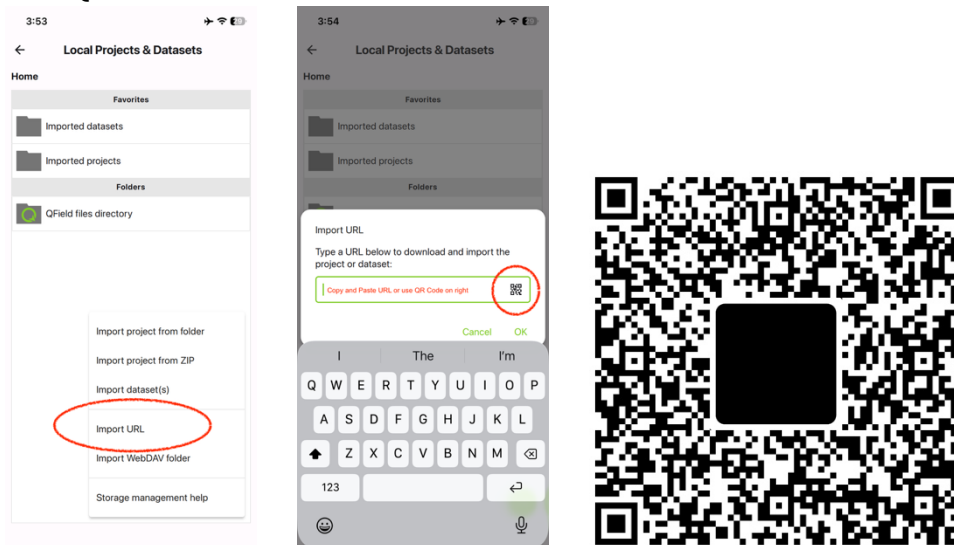
Once installed, open the app and select 'Local projects and datasets'. Then select the three-dot icon in the bottom right-hand corner.



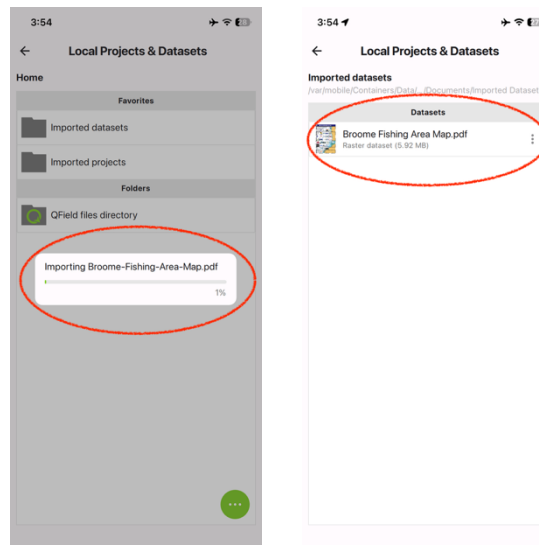
Select 'Import URL'. Copy and paste this URL:

Or select the QR Code scanner and scan the below code.



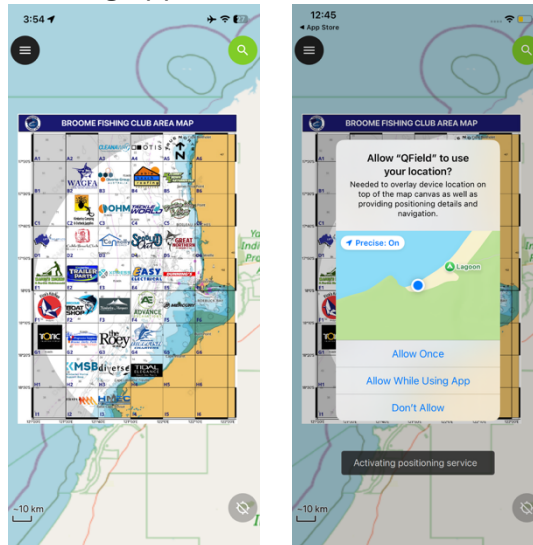
The Broome Fishing Area Map will begin to import. Once imported, select the map to open it.
