BGGF - Rules and Regulations

In order to participate, all competitors must register and pay their entry fee in full. Only registered female entrants may participate as anglers for each team, this includes adults and children. Children who are registered as junior entrants should be accompanied/supervised by an adult at all times. This competition is open to land based and offshore fishers.

Males may not participate in any act which directly contributes to the capture of a fish during the challenge. Their legal activities include, launching and skippering the boat, fetching drinks and snacks for anglers and also scoring catches.

Entry Costs - Juniors \$10 Adults \$15 Entry + Shirt \$60 Fishing will commence on Saturday 15th June 2024 at 6am. Lines out on Sunday 16th of June 2024 at 2pm.

SCORECARDS TO BE HANDED ASAP OR NO LATER THEN 4pm - ANY LATER SCORES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

All competitors must be present at the briefing and presentation nights to be eligible for any prizes.

All entries must be at the club no later than 6pm, briefing to follow soon after. Briefing will include how to score catches, any rules and regulations, raffles and teams will also pick up a comp bag.

When a competitor lands a fish, the scorecard must be filled out with the anglers name, fish species, length and a photo must be taken on any brag mat/measuring device with their BGGF card shown clearly in view.

Scores will be determined by points. - 10 points per fish ONLY LEGAL SIZE FISH MAY BE SCORED, SPECIES WILL ALSO BE CAPPED AT 4x PER ANGLER.

Refer to the Recfish West app for size and bag limits.

Please note! This competition is a catch and record competition based on a point score system and relies on the honesty of each team member. Fish must meet the legal minimum size limit to be eligible for a score. Fish may be retained, consumed or processed as per WA fisheries rules - please be familiar with them. The BFC encourages anglers to catch and release their catch.
