\*\*All Ranch Halter classes will enter the arena at the same time, but be judged by class division (W/T, NP and Open).

Walk/Trot exhibitors may NOT cross enter into ANY canter/lope (3-gait) class.

Show in 3 riding or Minis in 3 in-hand and/or driving classes plus 1 halter class to qualify for Daily and Yearend High Point Awards. Showmanship is the tie-breaker in all except Open, Ranch and Mini/Ponies, which is Halter.

Adding classes at the gate not allowed and must be done three classes in advance at the office. Tack change/gate-holds are not permitted at the gate and MUST be done 3 classes in advance, by filling out a 'Gate-hold' form at the office. Refunds for scratched classes will be given ONLY if done at the office 3 classes in advance by filling out a 'scratch form' at the office.
