WiFi Acceptable Use Policy (October 2023, reviewed May 2025)

Brome & Oakley Village Hall provides Wi-Fi internet access for legitimate users of the Village Hall. The WiFi facility is provided free of charge as a convenience to hall users (subject to point 9. below).

Brome & Oakley Village Hall is a charitable organisation (No. 1091952) and does not provide any technical support for this facility, nor does it provide any guarantees that you will be connected to the internet. Users should be aware of the possible security risks associated with connecting your computer to a network. It is the users' responsibility to keep their computers free from malicious code and secure them against unauthorised access.

By connecting to the Brome & Oakley Village Hall WiFi network users are deemed to have agreed to this Acceptable Use Policy.

Users agree:

- 1. Not to distribute spam content, malware or any other files that harm the integrity, security and confidentiality of any data belonging to any organisation or individual;
- 2. Not to access any illegal or harmful website;
- 3. Not to access any content or website which is defamatory, threatening, offensive or intimidating;
- 4. Not to access pornographic or other obscene, profane or abusive content;
- 5. Not to access or download any illegal or harmful content that compromises the integrity, security and confidentiality of any data belonging to any organisation or individual;
- 6. Not to use the network for any illegal activity;
- 7. Not to share the access credentials for the network with any other individual or third party;
- 8. Not to access network services in such a way as to deny reasonable access to the network for other users, for example, by excessive use of network bandwidth for music or video streaming or very large downloads;
- 9. Not to download more than 10Gb of data in any 24-hour period without prior consent. Additional bandwidth usage is subject to surcharge;

- 10. To report any faults to the Committee as soon as practicable;
- 11. Not to interfere with, adjust, disconnect or reset any of the network hardware unless instructed to do so by the Committee for troubleshooting purposes;
- 12. Only to access the network using a device with an up-to-date version of its operating system and adequate anti-virus protection;
- 13. That the protection of your devices from viruses or other malicious material is your responsibility and that Brome & Oakley Village Hall will not be responsible for any damage to your devices caused by connecting to the network:
- 14. That usage of the network may be monitored for the purposes of ensuring compliance with the acceptable use policy or managing the availability or performance of the network, hardware and connectivity;
- 15. That Brome & Oakley Village Hall accepts no responsibility for your usage of the network or any services you connect to via it and that you are solely responsible for such usage and any implications arising from it.
