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### REPORTS

#### Minister's report March/April 2021

- March/April was a big month in the life of St John's with our first in-person Easter Services since 2019
- Sunday Attendance went up and down 40,73,6 (119) 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday,39+39 (78) 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday , 44+55 (99) 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday, 18, 42,47 (107) Easter Sunday, 35, 34 (69) 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday
- Funeral were held this month for Nev Tuckey, Alex Henderson, and June Crump, May they rest in Peace and Rise in Glory
- David attended the Ningana Easter Service on March 26
- Ignite Youth met for their final session of the term on March 21 and had a Nerf war/Easter Egg hunt and spent some time thinking about Easter
- A Palm Sunday working Bee was held at St John's on March 27 with a faithful group of volunteers decorating the church, and David and Rev. Zoë helped lead the Warra Easter Service that evening with around 34 in attendance
- Our Easter service attendance was lower than past years, but it was great to be able to hold services with Maundy Thursday attracting 26 people for a reflective Eucharist and the First Communion Service for Hajiru Fasi, Good Friday saw 64 people gather for a reading of the stages of the cross from Mark's gospel, Good Friday in Cecil Plains was their soul Easter with 29 people in attendance, Easter Sunday saw three services take place with a Sunrise Easter Service (18), 8am (42), and 10am (47). Online engagement was strong (642 Facebook and 97 Youtube views) and advertising banners from Sundown Signs.
- On April 11 the Parish was treated to a special visit from our Mission Partner Bishop Daniel. In his sermon and interview with our Mission Partner Liaison, Colin Watters, Bishop Daniel shared details of the work he is doing in Australia currently with ethnic congregations, and how is supporting the people of Duk, South Sudan remotely. He encouraged us to pray for the people of South Sudan and the Ethnic congregations in the Brisbane Diocese.
- Bishop Daniel also launched our new Preaching series on April 11 called 'Light & Love' which will be a deep dive into the book of 1 John.
- The Browne family took leave from April 7 to April 13 and I've come back refreshed and looking forward to celebrating the Easter season.

#### Financial Report
