St John's Anglican Church – Parish of Dalby is a cohesive and established parish that has a strong sense of joy and compassion. We live our mission, “To know Christ and to make Christ known – through worship, reaching out, caring and education,” and the role of Associate Priest as furthering our outreach to young families and the wider district.

The role of Associate Priest is a central part of our Mission Plan. We are looking for a faithful minister of the gospel who will support and engage young families and inspire them to grow in their relationship with Jesus. This position is offered as a permanent position with a 6 month probationary period, and will require a commitment to working 24 hours per week or 0.6 of a full time load. Remuneration will be in-line 0.6 of a full-time diocesan regulation stipend for an associate priest (\$41,041 per annum), plus housing allowance, utilities (electricity, internet), fully maintained vehicle, mobile phone.

You will work alongside the Priest in Charge to serve the parish in pastoral care and sacramental ministry. You will develop the existing program for Young Families and roster of weekly services in the district. Working with various volunteers you will prepare lessons and material for Sunday Kid's Church and for our monthly Ignite Youth meetings. You will help resource rural church communities and assist in providing sacramental ministry for Dalby Parish and other churches in our region. You will also be required to attend Parish Council meetings on the second Thursday of every month.

Our successful applicant will be a faithful and prayerful disciple of Christ, a role model for our young families, with a high level of organisational skills and the ability to work autonomously. Someone who is ordained in the Anglican Church of Australia and is able to be licensed in the Diocese of Brisbane. Someone who has excellent interpersonal and communication skills with an ability to develop and maintain relationships with a wide range of people. Also someone who has a Blue Card (Working with Children Check).

Apply today and have the privilege of providing holistic and Christ centered teaching in an environment that encourages young people to grow and develop spiritually. Enjoy the opportunity to witness to young families cultivate mature relationships with each other and with Jesus, and establish their faith in fellowship with other believers in the parish.
