Job Title: Young Families Ministry Leader.

Hours: 20 hours per week with flexibility spread over a monthly period with a

view to expanding this role.

Employment: Permanent Part time for a contract period of three years.

Reporting: To and supported by the Priest in Charge and Parish Council.

Context

- Confident to briefly report outcomes.
- Prepared to raise up new leaders to join the YFM team.
- Ready to equip and empower parents to disciple their children.
- Subject to a successful Safe Ministry Check and to licensing by the Archbishop.
- Musical skills and abilities, although not a requirement, are highly desirable.

Responsibilities
