Arrival Time

9am - setup must be complete by 11am

Clean-up Policy

All vendors will be responsible for set up, cleanup of area, and break down of merchandise. Failure to do so will result in banning of future events.

No Show Policy

Vendors who are not onsite and set up by 11am will be considered a "no show," and will not be eligible for a refund. Please contact event organizers prior to 11am in the event of being late.

LOADING/UNLOADING

Vendors will be assigned a designated space and are allowed to drive to the assigned area to load/unload their booth during the set up and break down time. We ask the vendors do not start breaking down until 6pm.

CHECK-IN

Vendors must check in at The Powerhouse Nashville or Once A Dream Foundation booth prior to setting up.

LEGALITIES




The "Vendor" hereby agrees to:

- 1. Pay the NON-REFUNDABLE VENDOR FEE according to package choice.

- 3. Complete setup of display 1 hour before event begins. All vendors will be responsible for set up, cleanup of area, and break down of merchandise.

- 5. Complete, sign and return this contract along with your deposit fee upon acceptance of terms.
