WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$415,752.00, which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$315,900.00, and Total Appropriations of \$415,752.00; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 8, 2016 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017 is hereby approved; and

In the proposed budget for 2017, appropriations will increase by \$10,180.00 as compared to the 2016 adopted budget. This is a 2.5% increase. On budget page F-3 and F-3(Supplemental), certain individual lines are reflecting a variance with the 2016 adopted budget in excess of +/-10%. In the following table, these budget lines requiring explanation are presented:

- (1) The proposed budget for Administration Office Expenses includes the purchase of a replacement copier fax machine.
- (2) Costs previously budgeted as Other Outside Services has been combined with Maintenance and Repair. This combined proposed budget appropriation increased due to the change in service contract increase of \$3,850.00 and increased costs of Verizon Air cards of \$580.00.
- (3) The combined proposed budget for U.S.F.A. Equipment will increase \$1,400.00 for the purchase of a laptop computer used in U.F.S.A. services.
- (4) The 2017 proposed budget utilities will increase by \$500.00 due to an increase in the monthly fees from Comcast.
- (5) The 2016 adopted budget included an appropriation for two lease payments. The bank applied the additional payment entirely to principal, not as had been budgeted. The proposed 2017 budget also includes an appropriation for two lease payments which have been allocate as the bank will apply them. This resulted in a \$10,580.00 change in both appropriations.

The amount to be raised by taxation in the proposed 2017 budget of \$315,900.00 is the same as the 2016 adopted budget. The projected 2017 tax rate (three decimals) of \$0.084 is a decrease of \$0.001 from the 2016 adopted rate of \$0.085. In the proposed 2017 budget, the Fire District will utilize \$88,868.00 unrestricted fund balance to aid in tax rate stabilization. This will reduce undesignated fund balance by 24.3%.

The amount to be raised by taxation of \$315,900.00 in the proposed budget is less than the maximum amount allowed.
