In the proposed budget for 2022, anticipated revenues and appropriations will increase by \$57,905 as compared to the 2021 adopted budget. This is a 10.7% increase. On budget pages F-2 and F-3 and the associated appropriation detail pages, certain individual lines are reflecting a variance with the prior year adopted budget in excess of +/-10%. These are explained in item 3 below.

reason for the increase/decrease in the budgeted line item.
Page F-2, unrestricted fund balance utilized in 2022 of \$136,465 is in excess of the amount in 2021 of \$84,360.00 by \$52,105 (61.8%). This variance is the net result of variances in revenues and appropriations that will is explained in detail next. Anticipated interest income of \$1,000.00 reflects a decrease of \$1,000.00 (-50%) from the amount in the 2021 adopted budget of \$2,000.00 as the Fire District experienced less such revenue in 2021 due to the COVID-19 effect on financial markets, specifically the downtrend in interest rates. Page F-3, under Cost of Operations and Maintenance, Fringe Benefits of \$26,846.15 is an increase of \$3,686.15 (15.9%) over the \$23,160 amount in the 2021 adopted budget, driven by the increase in the cost of life insurance and workers compensation. Other Assets Non-bondable of \$49,750.00 is an increase of \$6,000 (13.7%) from \$43,750.00 in the 2021 adopted budget as equipment is needed for the new fire truck expected to arrive in 2022. There is an increase in Principal Payments on Debt Service of \$31,157.13 (100%) and Interest Payments on Debt of \$4,842.87 (100%) due to the addition of loan financing for the fire truck purchase into the budget, costs that did not exist in 2021.

The amount to be raised by taxation in the proposed 2022 budget of \$348,600.00 is a \$6,800 increase over the \$341,800.00 in the 2021 adopted budget. The projected 2022 tax rate (three decimals) of \$0.094 is an increase of \$0.002 from the 2021 adopted rate of \$0.092. In the proposed 2022 budget, the Fire District will utilize \$136,465 unrestricted fund balance to aid in tax rate stabilization. This amount is \$52,105 more than the amount utilized in the 2021 adopted budget and will reduce undesignated fund balance by 41.4%. Under the Property Tax Levy CAP, the amount to be raised by taxation is limited to a 2% increase over the amount from the prior year; however, certain adjustments are allowable additions in the calculation. The amount to be raised by taxation of \$348,600.00 in the proposed
