Troop 616 General Information

- The troop meets the first three Wednesday's of each month. Patrol Leader's Council meets the fourth Wednesday. If there are five Wednesday's in a month, there is no meeting the fifth Wednesday.
- Troop chartered organization is St. Gregory the Great Catholic Church.
- Meetings are held at St. Gregory's School at 15315 Stonebridge Parkway from 7:00-8:15 PM.
- There is usually one campout per month, usually the third weekend.
- The troop has been in existence for over 45 years.
- The troop has qualified as a Gold Unit for the Journey to Excellence Award
- We're proud of our 140 Eagle Scouts.
- The troop scoutmaster is Paul Honeycutt. He has extensive experience in scouting.
- The scoutmaster is assisted by trained assistant scoutmasters (Mike McCallum and Mike Sanders)
- The adults are trained and scouts are prepared for outings.
- The troop participates in many community service and Eagle projects.
- Scouts are expected to participate in at least 50% of meetings, outings, and community service projects.
- Registration is \$150 per year with a one-time equipment fee of \$50.
- Campouts cost approximately \$20 plus travel and food expenses.
