



Application Weather Update

Tuesday, June 9, 2026 – 9:45am Update

Dear Acres of Green Client,

I wanted to provide a quick update on today's scheduled Acres of Green applications.

At the moment, we're in a bit of a weather-related holding pattern.

Today's treatments, including liquid iron applications, weed control treatment and mosquito treatments, require approximately six hours of dry weather after application for the best results. Unfortunately, the current forecast is calling for rain beginning around 11:00 AM, which may not provide enough drying time.

Complicating matters, Wednesday and Thursday (June 10, 11) are forecast to reach temperatures near 90°F. To protect your lawn, most herbicide (weed control) applications should not be made when temperatures are expected to exceed 85°F, as excessive heat increases the risk of turf injury and unnecessary stress on the grass.

As a result, we may need to delay some applications until conditions improve, potentially as late as Friday. Please know that we're monitoring the forecast closely and will keep you informed as the week progresses.

One advantage of working with a smaller, locally owned company is the flexibility to adjust schedules when weather conditions aren't ideal. Proper timing is one of the most important factors in achieving great results while protecting your lawn. Our goal is never to simply complete an application... we want to apply products under conditions that give you the best outcome.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. We'll continue monitoring the weather and will provide updates as soon as we know more.
