From 2019 to 2024, hiring rates fell for workers in their 20s for roles that tend to require a bachelor's degree, while hiring rates rose for roles requiring a vocational or associate's degree...And during that five-year span, enrollment in bachelor's degree programs fell by 4%, while enrollment in vocational schools grew by 5%.
