Vegetables

Kohlrabi *Winner Improved*

Replacement for Grand Duke, Winner Improved is higher yielding with larger bulbs and later to pithiness.

Pepper *King Arthur*

Replacement for Big Bertha. King Arthur sets well in heat with large, true blocky fruit. It is also very disease resistant and quick to red.

Tomato *Sun Bliss, Sun Sugar*

Sun Bliss is our new yellow grape tomato that has very vigorous plant and fruit growth. Sun Sugar is a golden cherry tomato with high sugar content and good crack resistance.

Annuals

Begonia *Nonstop Sunset*

If you love the Illumination Apricot Shades, this is the Nonstop for you. Very similar in color but in an upright form instead.

Canna *Cannova Red Golden Flame*

Another addition to our collection of Cannas. A profusion of red/yellow bicolor blooms tops lush, green tropical foliage. Thrives in hot and humid conditions.

Dahlia *Dahlietta Paula*

Another unique color to add to our collection of Dahliettas. This Dahlia features double white flowers that are speckled and striped with rose-pink.

Diascia *Darla Red*

A red addition to these colorful, long-flowering plants. Diascia are very versatile, preferring cool season but very heat tolerant as well.

Gerbera *Patio Volcanoes*

Large flowering Gerbera Daisies that can add a wow factor to a deck, porch or patio. Blooms can measure up to 5 inches in diameter. They also make great cut flowers lasting up to 2 weeks in a vase.

Gomphrena *Truffula Pink*

The Proven Winners annual of the year. Truffula Pink performs very well in hot, humid conditions and blooms all season long. It makes a great cut flower with a long vase life.

Impatiens *Orange Star, Violet Star*

Two new colors to add to our collection of shade loving bedding Impatiens. These two colors offer a unique star pattern in both orange and violet.

Lantana *Luscious Lemon Tart*

A new yellow Proven Winners Lantana to replace Bananarama. Lantana offers great heat and drought tolerance that the butterflies and hummingbirds love.

Nemesia *Aromance Mulberry*

Another fragrant addition to our line of Nemesia. This is an early bloomer that is strong enough to withstand the summer heat.

Pansy *Frizzle Sizzle Mix*

Frizzle Sizzle is a unique mix of frilly ruffled Pansies. Another great early bloomer to brighten up a spot in early spring.

Petunia

Mambo Blue Vein, Mambo Rose Morn

Mambo Petunias are excellent bedding Petunias that are naturally dwarf. Blue Vein has large light blue flowers with darker veins and Rose Morn has pink flowers with white centers.

Portulaca

Colorblast Double Magenta

Large double glowing flowers that do not close up like the single flowered Portulacas. A low maintenance, heat and drought tolerant annual.

Thunbergia

Sunny Susy Amber Stripes

Unique pinwheel striped blooms of dark red edged in yellow. This vine will make a striking display growing up a trellis or fence.

Viola

Sorbet Pink Halo

This cool season beauty features white flowers with a raspberry pink halo.

Zinnia

Macarenia

Large double blooms are two-toned with gold and red. This unique bicolor is sure to catch the attention of anyone who sees it.

Perennials

Aruncus

Chantilly Lace

A part shade loving Proven Winners Goatsbeard. This plant produces sprays of lacy, cream-colored flowers on a plant that looks similar to Astilbe but is more drought tolerant.

Aster

Woods Blue

A low growing dwarf Aster with dainty purple daisy like flowers. They bloom in the summer and continue into fall.

Astilbe

Dark Side of the Moon

A Proven Winners variety with rich deep chocolate brown leaves. As the leaves emerge, they are yellow with a dark margin that turn dark as they age. The raspberry-colored buds open to rosy purple blooms.

Blackberry

Black Satin

A thornless, heat tolerant variety that boasts tons of very flavorful deep, dark purple blackberries.

Echinacea

Sunseekers Rainbow

Unique flowers with many different colors on one plant. Flowers open yellow then turn to hues of pink, blush, coral, lavender, salmon and more.

Gaillardia

Lunar Honey Moon

Bright yellow flowers with deep yellow cones that blooms all summer. Excellent heat tolerance that lasts into September.

Grass

Miscanthus High Frequency

Japanese Silver Grass with showy banded variegated foliage. An excellent upright focal point with a display of feather like seed heads in the fall.

Hellebore

Ice and Roses Red

Another variety from the Gold Collection, these sparkling ruby-red blooms face outwards and even upwards.

Lonicera

Major Wheeler

A cultivar of the honeysuckle native to the Eastern United States. This variety is one of the most profuse bloomers and disease resistant varieties available.

Papaver

Royal Wedding

These large, pure white flowers with a dark eye will steal the show from late spring to early summer.

Rudbeckia

Little Goldstar

Compact, clump forming Black Eyed Susan. Ideal for the front of the border and containers.

Salvia

Rose Marvel

Excellent dwarf variety with ultra large deep rose flowers. A pollinator favorite, attracting bees, butterflies and hummingbirds. Deer and rabbit resistant and drought tolerant once established.

Sedum

Mr. Goodbud

Large, dense heads on a compact plant. The light purple buds contrast with the dark purple flowers.

Nursery

Pear

Hosui Asian

Slightly higher acid content than other Asian pears. Fruit is sweet like a pear and crisp like an apple with lots of juice.

Hamamelis

Arnold's Promise

Sweetly fragrant, bright yellow flowers in late winter to early spring. Turns attractive shades of yellow and red in fall.

Hydrangea

Wee Bit Giddy, Let's Dance Arriba

Wee Bit Giddy is an improved version of the Cityline Paris Hydrangea. Sporting the same intense red flower color and dwarf habit but with added durability. Let's Dance Arriba is one of the most prolifically blooming and fastest growing Hydrangeas. Color is dependent on the pH of the soil.

Rose

Oso Easy Urban Legend

Bright red rose flowers from early summer until the first hard frost.

Weigela

Sonic Bloom Pink

Sonic Bloom are the best reblooming Weigelas. Tons of hot pink flowers in May are followed by waves of blooms until frost.
