Herbs

<u>Oregano</u> Greek

Herb commonly used in Mediterranean dishes, savored for its strong aroma and spicy intense flavor.

Annuals

<u>Angelonia</u> Angelface Wedgewood Pink

Angelonia are heat loving plants that grow best after temperatures warm up. This variety has bicolor pink and white blooms.

<u>Calibrachoa</u> Minifamous Double Red

A dark red addition to our popular line of double Callies.

<u>Canna</u> Cannova Gold Leopard

Create a tropical feel with these exotic leopard spotted yellow flowers.

<u>Celosia</u> Dragon's Breath

Unique green-red foliage with blazing red, long lasting flowers. This Celosia has fantastic performance under hot and humid conditions.

<u>Dahlia</u> Hypnotica Candy Corn

Large blooms showcase a unique tricolor of vintage yellows, oranges and reds. Performs well in both the garden and containers.

Helianthus Sunbelievable Brown Eyed Girl

Compact Sunflower that flowers continuously from spring until frost

Mandevilla Sunbeam

Yellow Mandevilla with a bushier habit. Great for sunny spots to add a tropical look.

Salvia Hummingbird Falls, Summer Jewel Red

Hummingbird Falls is the world's first hanging basket Salvia, featuring blue flowers and a unique mushroom habit. Summer Jewel Red is a new red Salvia that will be sure to bring in the hummingbirds.

Supertunia Mini Vista Yellow

Bright, sunshine-colored yellow blooms will perform well in the landscape or containers. The Mini Vistas have smaller flowers than the Vista Supertunias but the mass of flowers will create a blanket of color.

<u>Thunbergia</u> The Big White

An addition to our collection of Thunbergias, this variety has large white flowers with a black center.

<u>Verbena</u> Lanai Candy Cane

Clusters of white flowers with cherry red stripes, will make interesting color combos in hanging baskets and containers.

Perennials

Alyssum Golden Spring

Early spring masses of golden yellow flowers create a carpet like appearance. Deer and rabbit resistance make this a popular choice for the landscape.

Buddleia Miss Violet

Purple version of the Miss Molly Butterfly Bush. This variety also gets 4-5 feet tall and wide, attracts butterflies, bees and hummingbirds while resisting deer.

<u>Lavender</u> Sensational

Similar to the Phenomenal Lavender with more silvery foliage and slightly shorter habit.

<u>Pycnanthemum</u> muticum

Commonly called Mountain Mint, this native features silver foliage with a minty fragrance and is a great pollinator plant.

<u>Sedum</u> Sunsparkler Lime Twister

Two toned hardy succulent with lime green foliage edged in a buttery yellow. Blooms in late summer with rose pink flowers.

<u>Sempervivum</u> Colorockz Lemon Flare

This variety of Hens and Chicks changes color with the seasons. In fall and winter, it is lime green with small red highlights and webbing while in the summer it becomes lemon yellow with red accents.

<u>Viola</u> Silver Gem

A native groundcover with beautiful silvery-blue, heart shaped foliage. Small violet flowers bloom throughout spring and early summer.

Nursery

Kolkwitzia Pink Cloud

Commonly called Beauty Bush, this deciduous shrub typically grows 6-10' tall with an arching, vase-shaped habit. Bell-shaped, pink flowers appear in clusters in a mid-spring bloom.

<u>Lagerstroemia</u> Bellini Grape, Bellini Raspberry

These hardy Crape Myrtle, have a compact habit and are resistant to both deer and mildew. Bellini Grape features lavender colored blooms, while Raspberry has bright rose-colored blooms.

<u>Pear</u> Moonglow

Moonglow pears boast a soft, juicy texture that avoids the undesirable grittiness often encountered. They can be enjoyed fresh as well as used in cooking, canning and freezing. Moonglow serves as an effective pollinator for various other pear varieties.

<u>Prunus</u> Okame

This cherry is stunning as a specimen because it produces abundant, mildly fragrant, rosy pink flowers. The flowers appear earlier than most and last longer than other flowering cherries. Fall foliage ranges from bronzy red to bright orange.
