Resolutions originating at Convention need to be written as a "hard" copy with two delegate signatures, and a "soft or electronic" copy forwarded to the Department Secretary as soon as possible so that discussion and vote may take place. (2013) Resolutions presented by the vote of a unit need to be signed by at least two (2) qualified delegates from the Unit and forwarded to the Department Secretary thirty (30) days prior to Department Convention for registration and classification and issuing to respective committees. A resolution which has not been presented through the proper channels will not be considered.

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department of Arizona, Article VI, Sec. 7 reads, "District Presidents may serve two consecutive terms. (81)" and

WHEREAS, the Bylaws of the American Legion Auxiliary, Department's Constitution, DISTRICT, Article V, Sec.7 reads, "District Presidents may serve only two consecutive terms." and

WHEREAS, the two documents contradict themselves; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that changes be made to both the Constitution and Bylaws stating "Although not recommended, unless there is no eligible member nominated to serve as District President, a current District President may serve more than two consecutive terms."
