- More than 95% of school buses in the United States run on diesel fuel.
- Diesel exhaust is a known carcinogen and is linked to asthma and heart disease.
- Exposure to diesel exhaust has serious impacts on cognitive development.



- Children are especially at risk.
- Studies show disabled students. students of color, students from low-income families are more likely to ride school buses: ride them for longer.
