

HENNA CARE AND INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.Let henna fully dry do not re-wet paste unless you plan on leaving it on longer to darken. (leave for at least 6 hours to get the darkest stain)
- 2. If you smear your paste wipe off area of smear immediately. How the paste lays is what your design will look like.
- 3. Henna is fully dry when it turns black and crumbles off like cookie crumbs
- 4. Stain may be orange to light tan at first. (It will take 24 hours to fully darken)
- 5. Pools and frequent rubbing in area will cause stain to remove quicker. Soap exfolliating or lightning products will remove henna faster
- 6. Seal with cold water once your paste is off
- 7. Use essential oil eucalyptus rosemary or clove or Alma oil to help give intense color. (Stay away from other moisture in henna location.
