Annual HOA Assessments

Each Rockwood homeowner is responsible for paying annual assessments by February 28th of each year. Assessments are currently \$230.00 with invoices mailed the first week of January. A \$100 fee will be assessed for late payments. The HOA has a Late Fee and Collection Policy available upon request.

Rockwood Recreational Facility and Swimming Pool

A summer of fun is available to you at the Rockwood Recreational Facility (RRF). The private, limited membership facility is dedicated to bringing friendly, family-focused, safe recreation at an affordable price to its member families. The playground area, basketball court, as well as the sand volleyball court, are open throughout the year. Social events such as an Easter egg hunt, Celebrate Safe Communities in the fall and a neighborhood picnic to celebrate the beginning of summer are examples of other activities offered in the neighborhood.

Membership to the RRF Pool brings the benefits of a heated and guarded pool with a fenced kiddie pool, shaded deck area, picnic tables, full-service concessions, and social events, just to name a few! A large capital improvement program has recently been completed making the Rockwood Pool facility one of the best in the city. Swim lessons are offered each summer for a nominal fee. Rockwood's swim team competes in GWSL competitions through the summer racing season.

Membership categories include family, two-person and single memberships. Rockwood homeowners and their dependents living in the home are eligible for discounted memberships upon payment of annual Rockwood assessments. Annual membership applications will be sent in early February. Covenants

We are a covenant community. All homeowners are responsible for reading and following the covenants. By accepting title to your home, you have accepted responsibility to abide by the covenants. The covenants can be found on our website or will be provided upon request.

The Rockwood Board has contracted with HOA Management Services to oversee daily operations of the neighborhood including maintenance, accounting and covenant enforcement. Homeowners will be given written notice if a covenant violation occurs and given a timeframe to resolve the issue.

As you make landscaping and structural improvements to your home; the fastest way to increase the value of your property, please contact HOA Management Services to review your plans to determine if approval from the Rockwood Board of Directors is necessary. Fences (new or replacement), decks, additions, sheds and paint color are among the most common improvements that may require approval. The covenants contain more specific information.

Community Trash Service

Waste Connections provides a greatly discounted rate for Rockwood homeowners, much lower than the standard residential rates, making it the preferred trash hauler for our neighborhood. Waste Connections provides the option of using a 95 or 65 gallon cart, as well as recycling as an optional service also offered at a discount. Call 316.838.4920 to set up residential service and be sure to mention you are a homeowner in the Rockwood community. A commercial-sized dumpster in the RRF parking lot is available for your bulky or excess trash as there is space available in the dumpster. If it's full, please be a good neighbor and hold your refuse until it has been emptied – don't set trash around or outside the dumpster.

Safety and Security

Be a good neighbor, help watch out for anything that looks out of the ordinary. Please call 911 if you see something/someone suspicious.

Rockwood Communications

Rockwood sends a periodic newsletter to each homeowner which includes upcoming community events and community policing information.
