Rockwood Directory – Online Access

In the past, Rockwood has provided a paper directory of its homeowners to all Rockwood homeowners. We will no longer provide a paper version. *Rockwood now has a mechanism to provide updated directory information on its website, <https://rockwoodneighborhood.org/>, to current homeowners – accessible by invitation only.*

To set up and access takes only a few minutes. Current homeowners will be “invited” via email to access by Rockwood. Homeowners set and control their own password. Homeowner information in the Rockwood directory cannot be changed by anyone, even your own. Information is updated monthly.

Currently only names and addresses are provided on the directory. Phone and email information, as available from HOA Management, is in the process of being added. Information concerning children and pets will NOT be provided.

Homeowners can correct their information on the directory page, provide suggestions to improve the site or opt-out entirely by emailing the Rockwood gmail administrator at rockwoodhomeownersassociation@gmail.com. ***This directory information is For Private Use Only, provided as a courtesy for Rockwood homeowners and is not to be provided in any format to anyone outside of Rockwood, for any purpose.***

- 1) Send email to rockwoodhomeownersassociation@gmail.com, to generate the invite, if you have not already received. *This will also add you to Rockwood gmail account to receive emails regarding neighborhood events and security concerns.* We do not provide outside access to our email information.
- 2) You will receive email *as shown* giving you access to “Private Page” on the website. Click on Create a Password and you’re ready to go. *Initial access expires within 24 hours.*
- 3) Rockwood does NOT have access to your password. If you forget your password, email Rockwood gmail to reset. One password per email address. If password is lost or initial access request expires, just send email to Rockwood gmail to reset.

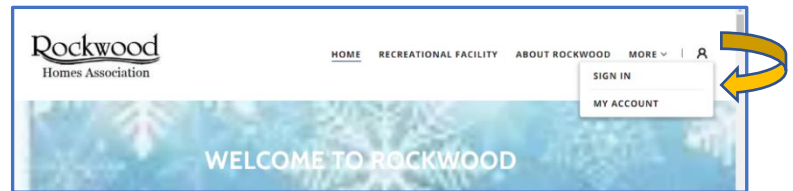
