Basketball/Pickleball Courts Re-build – Other RRF Projects Complete – Time to Play!

The basketball courts and goals were well-used and overdue for renovation. As it was never unusual to see a group of kids head to the RRF for an afternoon of basketball, updating that area became a priority this fall. The concrete pad has been replaced as have the goal posts/nets. The pickleball court concrete pad has been *enlarged to regulation size*. 50 tons of sand has been added to the volleyball area, as have solar lights to lengthen play time during the season.
