In the News....

Dumpster at RRF Removed

The dumpster in the RRF parking lot has been removed because of the continual dumping overages, expense and safety concerns. Options to restrict access to the dumpster and even to the parking lot itself were either attempted or considered and not viable at the current time. The dumpster will return to the RRF for the summer the first part of May.

The Rockwood clean-up day with the large commercial dumpster is still scheduled for Saturday, April 11th.

Covenant Enforcement Fines Process

The Board is currently reviewing options for assessing fines for non-compliance with Rockwood covenants, including actions taken by other HOAs, applicable covenant restrictions and advice of legal counsel. Once a course of action is determined, the matter will be brought before the homeowners for a vote by early fall..

The covenants were created to help protect the quality and value of our homes but lacked enforcement capabilities. This move will help rectify this oversight. We are neighbors first, but the board has a responsibility to work to uphold the documents that govern and protect Rockwood in the long-term. A full set of Rockwood's covenants is available on the website. If you have direct questions/concerns about these or other covenants, please speak with a board member or come to a meeting.

Recreational Facility Getting Major Improvements

It's time for the RRF building to get some much-needed improvements to the restrooms and showers. The Board is currently reviewing bids to replace plumbing fixtures and benches and paint. Work will be done in stages starting this spring but not to interfere with summer pool season. The baby pool water circulation issues will also be addressed. The pool itself is also being closely checked for any needed repairs, including new plaster. More information will be available at the annual meeting.

There is already a lot of planning to prep for the May 22nd pool opening!



In addition to a new pool cover and planning of the facility updates to the restrooms and showers and the repair of the baby pool, there are sitting in the patio room 36 brand new lounge chairs to match the orange and aqua RRF theme. The success of the expanded adult swimming hours in August has us looking to possibly include some evening hours for adults as well.

Swimming lessons are being reformatted to enhance the learning experience, with new swimming coaches, Elijah DeFore and Jordan Kleeman coming on board – new faces, but similar swimming backgrounds looking forward to building on prior year successes.

Look for pool membership information in the mail and on-line in early March. Memberships are available at several levels (*upon payment of annual Rockwood assessments*) for both in- and out-of-Rockwood homeowners.

Rockwood's Pool Program is full of amenities:

- Full-sized, heated swimming pool w/fenced baby pool
- Full-time guard staff
- Open 1:00-9:00 p.m. every day (weather permitting). From 12:00-1:00 is adult lap swim only, without lifeguards except for rare occasions for special events.
- Concessions and patio room for parties
- 2 full-sized sand volleyball courts
- Adjacent fenced-in park area with expanded playground equipment, basketball & pickleball court
- **Swim Team** for kids from ages 5-18
- **Swim Lessons** – group & private

Over 100 swimmers participate in swim team. Swim lessons were practically full each session. SIGN UP EARLY!

If you have someone in your house (15 and up), who would like to apply to be a lifeguard please contact Joe at the email below. Slots fill up in January, so be quick.

You will also receive a one-month free credit for new homes. The quarterly fee for standard trash pickup is \$49.71.

Homeowners can place up to five (5) bags with their trash for no additional fee. If you have a mattress/box springs to trash, please call Waste Connections. For a \$30 fee, they will pick up at your home.

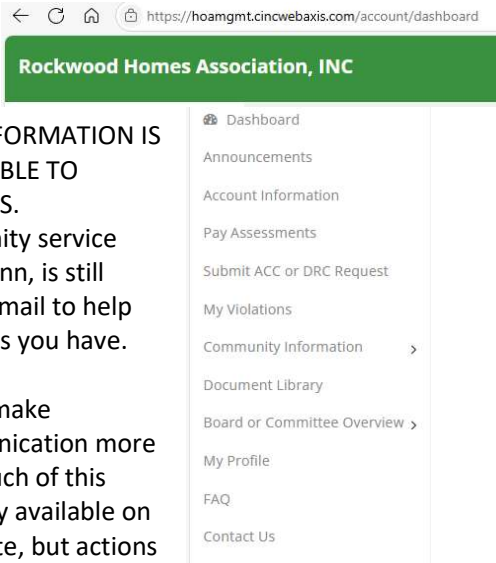

HOA Management Website Is Information Resource for Homeowners

HOA Management Services provides a number of administrative services for Rockwood, including financials, neighborhood inspections and related correspondence, as well as process architectural improvement requests. Over the past year HOA Management has made some software changes to its website, creating a portal for its neighborhood associations to access information/forms for their respective associations on its site. THIS ACCESS IS NOT REQUIRED BY ROCKWOOD OR HOA MANAGEMENT, AND ROCKWOOD INFORMATION IS NOT VISIBLE/ AVAILABLE TO OTHER ASSOCIATIONS. Rockwood's community service manager, Chantel Dunn, is still available by phone/email to help address any questions you have.

The site is meant to make information/ communication more easily attainable. Much of this information is already available on the Rockwood website, but actions such as paying dues, filing an architectural request form or communicating regarding covenant questions can be handled on the HOA Mgmt site. Rockwood homeowners, if they choose, can now register through the "My HOA Connect" app or its online site <https://hoamgmt.cincwebaxis.com> to utilize these services. Just follow the registration instructions; you will receive an email from donotreply@cincsystems.com once your Rockwood registration is confirmed, granting access with a link to create your password.

AUTO BURGLARY/VANDALISM TIPS

- **NEVER LEAVE VALUABLE ITEMS VISIBLE FROM OUTSIDE** (money (even just coins), purses, wallets, bags/backpacks, electronic equipment – computers/tablets/GPS units, cell phones, checkbooks, briefcases, sunglasses, mail/documents, guns, etc.)
- **ALWAYS LOCK YOUR VEHICLE**
- **PARK IN A WELL-LIT AREA**, visible from a window
- **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE RUNNING WHEN UNATTENDED**
- **BE ACTIVE IN A NEIGHBORHOOD BLOCK WATCH**
- **PARK IN A GARAGE OR, AT LEAST, IN THE DRIVEWAY**, if a garage is not available
- **ENSURE YOUR GARAGE DOOR IS CLOSED**
- **UTILIZE GOOD LIGHTING TO ILLUMINATE AROUND VEHICLES**
