IBW Favorite Product List

Below is a curated list of some of Iron Butterfly Wigs' favorite hair care products. While none are required, many clients have found them helpful in extending the life and appearance of their wigs. We update this list occasionally as we discover new favorites.

Electric Hot Comb

Most wigs include "return hairs"—shorter strands created during the knotting process. These hairs can sometimes stick up, especially with static, and while they're essential to the structure of the wig, they may need taming. A temperature-controlled electric hot comb is ideal for gently smoothing these hairs near the roots. Be cautious around lace areas and avoid holding heat in one place too long. A light pass-through is typically all that's needed. Also useful for light styling and touch-ups.

Hair Wax Stick

A wax stick is excellent for applying a light layer to the roots before using a hot comb. It helps lay down return hairs, reduces flyaways, and minimizes static. Many good options are available, and a little goes a long way.

Adjustable Heat Styling Tools

Always use heat tools with adjustable temperature settings to protect your wig. Low heat settings help preserve the integrity and longevity of the hair fibers.

Hair Oil

An IBW favorite is **CHI Silk Infusion**. Apply sparingly to dry hair after washing and allow the wig to fully dry. Then use a flat iron on low heat to add softness, shine, and manageability.

• Wig Grip

We recommend **silicone wig grips** for secure and comfortable wear. For a better fit, consider cutting the grip lengthwise to create a slimmer band. This helps reduce pressure while still holding the wig in place.

Aquage Beyond Shine

This lightweight spray offers shine, silkiness, and heat protection. It works beautifully on both straight and curly hair and is often preferred over heavier hair oils.

• Ionic Bonding Spray

From **Brazilian Blowout**, this spray helps seal the hair cuticle, locking in moisture and smoothness. It's especially beneficial for blonde or curly hair and helps extend the life of color treatments.

Olaplex

This bond-building treatment strengthens and repairs damaged hair. It's especially effective for blonde or curly textures. Note: **Olaplex No. 3** is not a conditioner, so always follow it with a moisturizing conditioner.

Silicone Mix (Argan Oil Treatment)

A go-to deep treatment, especially when hair feels dry or lifeless. The **Argan Oil version** is a favorite and can be easily found on Amazon. It restores moisture, softness, and manageability.
