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#### **Executive Director's Letter – Winter/Spring 2023**

Last year, the Community Park District of La Grange Park made three BIG new year's resolutions: (1.) Listen To You, (2.) Initiate Big Park Improvements, and (3.) Improve Accessibility. As we close out 2022, I am amazed by the impact our board and staff has made by focusing on these initiatives.

**Listen To You** – We implemented a full year of feedback into our comprehensive Master Plan, which was approved on August 8, 2022. This plan is a roadmap for the next 5 years of operational and capital goals. You can check out the full plan here: https://www.communityparkdistrict.org/about/master-plan In addition, based on what you have asked for, we have added several NEW programs starting this season, including:

- Adult Nerf Warz (Yes, it's finally happening!)
- A full day, 5-day Pre-K classroom in Ready Teddy for the 2023/24 School Year
- Increased 55 and over adult programming including Out on the Town Lunches and trips

**Initiate BIG Park Improvements** – In September of 2022, we applied for a \$600,000 OSDLAD grant to help offset funding needs for a complete overhaul of Yena Park. The park district has comprehensive plans for both Yena and Beach Oak Parks (which can be found in our Master Plan, see link above). We hope to break ground on both projects in 2023.

We are also proud to have brought on a dedicated ballfield specialist in the Spring of 2022. The addition to this position to our park's maintenance team has greatly improved the safety and aesthetics of our ballfields. Thanks in part to Little League, there were also significant improvements made to Hanesworth Park this past season.

Improve Accessibility – Not only have we tackled ADA Transition Plan improvements through the Yena and Beach Oak Park renovation plans, but we also added a dedicated inclusion specialist to our team for the 2022/23 Ready Teddy School Year. This position helps to evaluate students that may require additional assistance, provides support to teachers and students as needed, serves as a one-on-one inclusion aide, provides social and emotional assistance for all students, and evaluates our curriculum and implements changes and modifications to ensure every child has an incredible learning experience here at the Community Park District.

As we move into 2023, we will focus on implementing our new mission of supporting a healthy and inclusive community by positively impacting physical, social, emotional, and environmental well-being for all our residents and neighbors.

To achieve this important mission, we will keep the following core values at the forefront of our planning and implementation as we develop and improve programs, services, and spaces:



Our preschool is designed for children ages 2-5 years. Our curriculum is based on a non-repetitive 4-year cycle.

The Illinois Early Childhood Standards and Benchmarks are implemented into our innovative learning curriculum. Registration will open in February.

#### Fall 2023 Registration:

Registration for School Year 2023-2024 requires a non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00.

Proof of residency is required for La Grange Park residents (Ex: water, gas or electric bill). All necessary paperwork can be picked up prior to registration at the Recreation Center or can be found on our Community Park District website.

#### Registration applications will be accepted as follows:

Current preschool class **resident** families will be on Monday, February 13th at 8:30 am.

All **resident** families will be on Tuesday, February 14th at 8:30 am.

Current preschool class **non-resident** families will be on Thursday, February 16th at 8:30 am.

Registration is open to <u>all</u> on Friday, February 17th at 8:30 am.

#### **Before and After Care Programs:**

Before and after school care is an optional program which can be combined with our Ready Teddy Preschool Classes. This program is offered 8 am to 5pm (ABC is not offered on party days or school days off). Schedule is based on needs of students. Students of Ready Teddy can register for the ABC program on their designated class days. Limit of 4 hours per day. ### MUSICAL THEATER DANCE LYRICAL DANCE /HIP HOP

As a musical theatre performer, you will want to be well trained in all forms of dance. Ballet, Tap, Jazz, Theatrical (Broadway), ballroom, and even hip-hop.







The Community Park District of La Grange Park was awarded a \$8,265 grant to complete a comprehensive tree inventory and develop a management plan to help us best care for our urban forest. Thanks to a strong relationship with the Village of La Grange Park, our public trees have been inventoried within the village's GIS system, giving us a comprehensive picture of what we currently have and the tools we need to work together to improve our tree canopy. This will provide an incredible and efficient historical resource that will impact our community for generations.

The park district will utilize the comprehensive tree management plan to better budget for tree planting and care, species diversification, staff training, pest control and disease mitigation. It will also provide opportunities for the park district and Village of La Grange Park to work more collaboratively on the development and care of La Grange Park's urban forest.

Urban trees are critical infrastructure for every community. They clean our air and our water, reduce flooding and heat, improve our mental and physical help and provide important habitats for birds and other wildlife.

The funds for this grant were provided by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Forest Service through the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) Urban and Community Forestry Core Grant Program and administered by The Morton Arboretum and the Chicago Region Trees Initiative (CRTI).

- 1. **Resident Registration:** Online and walk-in resident registration will begin on Thursday, August 4, at 8:30 am. To register online, go to www.communityparkdistrict.org. For walk-in registration, visit the Park District office at 1501 Barnsdale Road, during business hours. Residents may only register their own family members.
- 2. **Non-resident Registration:** Online and walk-in registration for non-residents begins Thursday, August 11, at 8:30 am. To register online, go to www.communityparkdistrict.org. For walk-in registration, visit the Park District office during normal business hours.
- 3. First Come, First Served: All programs have a minimum and maximum enrollment and will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
- 4. Program Waiting Lists: Maximum enrollments for programs ensure quality and safety for all participants. Waiting lists will be established. Program rosters are monitored for withdrawals and waiting lists are contacted as spots become available. Residents on a waiting list are given priority when an enrollment becomes available.

### PETS IN THE PARKS POLICY

Animals - No person shall bring any animal in or upon any CPD property without first obtaining a permit from the CPD, unless enrolled in a park district sponsored dog training program. Service animals are excluded from this policy.

- 1. Dogs are strictly prohibited from all CPD events, except for special events where animals are part of the event with prior CPD approval; from all athletic fields, all tennis courts, all basketball courts; all playgrounds; and parks, except those designated as "Dog Friendly".
- 2. CPD "Dog Friendly Parks" are defined as:
  - A. Memorial Park
  - B. Hanesworth Park
  - C. Robinhood Park
  - D. Stone Monroe Park
- 3. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to run freely in any park, including "Dog Friendly Parks."
- 4. Dogs must be securely fastened and restrained by a leash not more than six feet in length at all times.
- 5. Dog licenses and proof of vaccinations must be displayed on the dog's collar.
- 6. No person owning or keeping a dog shall allow such dog to enter upon or remain upon any area of the park utilized as an athletic field, court, children's play area, or posted to prohibit dogs.
- 7. Owners or keepers of dogs shall carry appropriate equipment to and shall immediately clean the dog's waste and deposit the waste in an appropriate waste receptacle.
- 8. Aggressive or nuisance animals are prohibited from all parks.
- 9. Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior or nuisance barking, must be removed from the park immediately.
- 10. Any person found in violation of this section shall be fined not less than \$50 or more than \$250 Please notify us if you see violations of this policy by emailing jcannaday@communityparkdistrict.org.
