"Give Their Children to Famine"	(Jeremiah's Revenge; Jer 18:21-22)
"Give their children to famine; Put them to death by the sword..."	
"Woe to You"	(The Reverse Beatitudes; Luke 6:24-26)
"Curse God and Die"	(Job 2:9; tune: "Lift High the Cross")
