



A Family Journey

To my faithful friends and forever family: most of you know that my family serves our community through Christian radio. I'm a content creator. I'm sharing this in hopes you'll join me for a trip down memory lane. If you know we're in radio, then you know that sometimes I refer to the station and tower as a lighthouse—that light which can never go out—and so it is with the station. Most who know us understand it is our pleasure to help build a stage for others, especially for Abba Father. I prefer not being in a spotlight; it's way too bright for me! How does all this tie together with my cover image? It's the back porch from a trip we took to the mountains a few years ago. Stay with me...;-)

Not even when the kids were younger and we'd go to the mountains for a Christmas vacation did we really get to focus on just us. The station alarms would go off daily at us—even on vacation. Suffice it to say that being on call 24/7/365 was a challenge getting hubby's mind off work for this one week alone, yet so worth it. As part of local media, we learned from the beginning to enjoy Christmas and New Year's Day off. So, to stretch it out for the week, I started booking a cabin for the whole week each year so we could go to the mountains together with our four little ones. The first time we went, the three girls and I were sitting in the hot tub on the deck just after dark. We settled into all the warmth and majestic beauty which surrounded us up on the mountain when it started to snow—the very first night! Hubby and our son came running out when they heard all the excitement! Locals said it was the first time in a decade it came down like that, but I know that it was a wink from Abba Father. He's so kind that way; He's in the big things, but He's also in the details, as this was a desire of my heart.

Over the next few days, the kids played in the snow with their dad while it lasted and even learned how to ice skate too! Some years, the cabin we rented was out of range for cell phone service. Wasn't that a blessing?! Though at the time, it could be a struggle for any of us on any given day. Still, there was plenty to do together if we just looked—observe, as it were. We usually went to town daily, so the closer we got, cell service resumed. Thank goodness for the sweet release of returning each time to our own place with a game room, which featured a pool table, various games, and usually a wet bar with its conveniences since the game rooms are usually situated in a loft or basement. Always something to venture into, especially when we really engaged by having our meals at the cabin as much as possible. Cooking was a small price to pay for the beauty of family gathered together. I was once told that King David used his table as an altar before the Lord, where he offered blessings all in honor of our Great King, thanking Him continually for everything. Those were really great times.

But now, I hear the call from the mountain once again as my soul yearns to be in the cleft of the rock because I long to see His face, up close and personal. It begins with a journey—much like that of the Children of God; we are grateful for the cloud by day and fire by night where He led daily with His cloud of protection and His Fire by night. We don't need to go to a mountain to see His face. We simply ask right where we stand. That's all there is to it. I've very recently discovered it's not even necessary to carry our baggage to Him. Honestly, it can be so heavy, hard to budge, let alone carry in our own strength. When we ask Him to carry it for us, then, like the loving Father He is, He will reach down lovingly and gently, saying, "I've got it, darling." He'll carry us too! ASK—three little letters with so much weight. If we need anything, we need only to ask.

All Night with the King-The night of prayer that led to the holiest experience of my life—as I sat in my rocker at home on the porch, the night sky seemed to wrap me like a cocoon. The brightly lit cherry tree, a symbol of life's brevity, renewal, and God's light, became a soft glow as I reflected on distant memories with my children—those days of running to the hills to spend time with my own little army and also to connect more deeply with my Abba Father, as I've longed for Him. I was thinking about an acquaintance I recently had the pleasure of connecting with; it was a divine connection. As he prayed for my family, a dove lit right beside him where he was sitting on a park bench—not on the handle or back of the bench, but right beside him. It seemed to look into his eyes and then gently fly away. He knew our families would be friends—we would be friends. What a beautifully divine sign from the Creator of heaven and earth! As my thoughts rolled from one image to another, "Way Maker," performed by Danny Gokey on the White House Lawn in 2018, surged through my soul. Then I heard another song, "You Belong to the Lord," by Project of Love. My mountain image glowed with billows of love as I focused on it. I heard my Abba Father graciously reach down and say, "I've got you, darling. Let me help." I heard Him speak to me, and then He carried me on His wings, continually restoring my health because He comes with healing in His wings, according to Malachi 4:2.

In the morning hours, the trembling, tears, and exhaustion met joy as my shoulders dropped and my neck eased. Laughter broke through—a miracle unfolded! The left side of my airways, closed by Bell's Palsy since 2016, opened wide (Malachi 4:2)! Breathing freely on holy ground where angels stood (Exodus 3:5), I knew Isaiah 53:5's promise: "by His wounds we are healed." Trembling faith had led to prayer answered! I prayed, "Here am I—send me" (Isaiah 6:8), after stepping into a transformational night with the King. Later, because Abba knows I lean heavily on the joy of the Lord as my strength—a Home Alone moment echoed Kevin's "I'm not afraid anymore!" in my spirit (Psalm 18:33). Memories of family—my little army backpack days—resurfaced, reflecting divine order as if to point me to our beloved Commander in Chief and all those who serve under him, from top to bottom, in our nation and the sacrifices made in times past and even now. Trembling persisted, a holy quaking (Philippians 2:12). I prayed, "Gird my legs that I may stand..." (Psalm 18:32), as I sensed the seal of the King's Ring (Esther 8:8). Fear became a foundation of prayer covering all the Angel Armies of the heavens where the Lord of Hosts stands on guard to protect and defend continually (Hebrews 1:14)—a perfect reflection of those military forces who do the same for us in the earth now. As the commander Joshua, at Jericho, was anointed with wisdom and strength, Joshua 6:2-5 states: "And the LORD said to Joshua, 'See, I have given Jericho into your hand..." God gave the divine strategy, and the walls collapsed miraculously, fulfilling His promise!

A dove swooped by my porch by mid-morning light—peace descended (Genesis 8:11). The Hebrew letter Bet (value=2) revealed my home as a sanctuary (Psalm 93:5), a place of God's presence. His timing affirmed my path (Psalm 32:8). Signs spoke louder than words by now. This night reshaped me, for I had spent the whole night with the King, our Messiah, who continues to be with me and restore me along the Way—even now as I write this trembling before Him.

From family togetherness on the mountain back then to seeking His face now in prayer has strengthened my resolve to worship Him even more. He brings healing in His wings. He will dwell with us, angels encamp round about our homes (Psalm 34:7). It's a gift and a blessing to express His love with intention in our daily comings and goings. Ask to see His face: together as a family and as a nation. Pray for those who lead us and our beloved nation. May our nation rise in unity, healing, and peace, sealed with the King's Ring! May you and all those you love most be blessed in your journey (Psalm 119:105) and may He bless our love for one another as we carry it out to the ends of the earth. God bless the USAL
