



BYLAWS OF DASH DOGS AND SECOND HOMES, INC.

Adopted: April 24th, 2026

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization shall be **DASH Dogs And Second Homes, Inc.** (hereinafter referred to as "DASH" or "the Organization").

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

DASH Dogs And Second Homes, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purpose of the Organization includes, but is not limited to:

- Rescuing dogs from municipal shelters and animal control facilities;
- Providing foster-based care and medical rehabilitation;
- Facilitating adoption into permanent, screened homes;
- Reducing euthanasia rates through direct-to-home rescue models;
- Promoting responsible pet ownership and community education.

ARTICLE III: BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. General Powers. The affairs of DASH shall be managed by its Board of Directors.

Section 2. Number of Directors. The Board shall consist of no fewer than three (3) directors.

Section 3. Board Officers. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of:

- **President:** Victoria Blossom
- **Vice President:** Elena Yarsh
- **Secretary:** Rebecca Roe
- **Treasurer:** Violet Blossom

Section 4. Terms. Board members shall serve a term of two (2) years and may be reappointed by a majority vote.

Section 5. Removal. A board member may be removed by majority vote of the Board if it is determined to be in the best interest of the organization.

ARTICLE IV: OFFICERS AND DUTIES

- **President:** Shall provide strategic leadership, preside over all board meetings, oversee daily operations, and execute legal documents on behalf of DASH.
- **Vice President:** Shall assist the President in their duties and act as the presiding officer in the President's absence.
- **Secretary:** Shall maintain all corporate records, record meeting minutes, provide meeting notices, and ensure organizational transparency.
- **Treasurer:** Shall oversee all rescue finances, maintain accurate financial records, provide quarterly reports, and ensure tax and legal compliance.

ARTICLE V: MEETINGS

Board meetings shall be held as needed, but no less than quarterly. A majority of board members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Decisions shall be made by a majority vote of those present.

ARTICLE VI: COMPENSATION & CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Section 1. Compensation. No board member shall receive compensation for their services as a director. Directors may be reimbursed for pre-approved expenses incurred on behalf of DASH.


Section 2. Conflict of Interest. Board members must disclose any potential conflicts of interest. Any member with a conflict shall abstain from voting on related matters.

ARTICLE VII: DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the organization, all remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. No assets shall benefit any individual director or officer.

The Board of Directors of **DASH Dogs And Second Homes, Inc.** hereby adopts these Bylaws as the official governing document of the Organization, effective as of the founding date: **April 24th, 2025.**
