Dear Parents:

Thank you for your interest in our Pre-K program for next fall 2023-2024 school year. Please fill out the form below and as soon as you turn it in, our Director will add you to the brightwheel app through your email address. Once you join brightwheel, the registration fee will be added to your account. This assures your child a place in our school and is a non-refundable fee. All payments will only be accepted through brightwheel. You must schedule a tour (with your child) in order to be accepted into our program.

We enroll children based upon the following criteria:

- 1) Must be 3 years of age by Sept. 1st.
- 2) Must be potty trained.
- 3) Presently enrolled in the Owl's Nest Program
- 4) Early inquiry or visit.

In August, The Owl's Nest will message you through brightwheel with the orientation date and the date school starts, traditionally after Labor Day, September 5th. You must have all the following turned in before orientation:

- 1) Immunization records and signed form by your child's doctor.
- 2) All enrollment forms filled out and turned in. You may drop it by the church office if we are not available.
- 3) Last month's tuition payment through brightwheel only.
