Membership Terms & Conditions

Who We Are

Millview Swim Club was founded in the 1970s as a small community club and became a swim club in 1980 through the efforts of local families.

Millview is a **not-for-profit, volunteer-run organization**. We receive no funding from the city, county, or state. The club depends on member participation to stay safe, clean, and enjoyable.

The Board of Directors (President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary) and additional volunteers help manage operations, events, and maintenance. **Board members are volunteers and are not paid for their service.** They serve two-year terms and contribute significant time each year.

General Expectations

Failure to follow these rules may result in loss of membership without refund.

All members, guests, and employees are expected to help maintain a safe and respectful environment at all times.

Facility & Grounds

- Use of the pool is limited to members and their guests, unless the facility is reserved.
- Anyone on the property after hours without permission is considered trespassing.
- Please clean up after yourself.
- The guard shack phone is for emergency use only (911 access).
- Unsafe or improper use of the facility may result in removal.

Code of Conduct

The following are not allowed:

- Alcohol or illegal drugs
- Smoking or vaping
- Profanity or inappropriate behavior



- Disrespect toward lifeguards or ignoring their instructions

Lifeguards have full authority to enforce rules and may ask anyone to leave.

Membership & Guests

- Membership is limited to immediate family living in the same household.
- Members may bring up to 5 guests per visit.
- Guest fee: \$5 per person, \$25 maximum per family.
- Each guest may visit up to 5 times per season.
- Members must sign in upon arrival (used to track pool usage, especially during low-attendance periods).
- Proper swim attire is required (no cutoffs or non-swim clothing).
- Please do not wear swimsuits used in lakes or creeks without washing them first (helps prevent contamination).
- Music should be family-appropriate.

Photos: Membership implies consent for photos to be used on club communications unless written notice is provided.

Child Safety

- Children under 12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
- Lifeguards are present, but parents are ultimately responsible for their children and guests.
- Baby pool is limited to children 4 and under with a caregiver.
- Lifeguards may require a swim test at their discretion.

Gate Access

- Each family receives one gate key.
- A key is required for entry. Lifeguards will not leave their post to provide access.
- Keys may not be shared with non-members (except caregivers for member children).
- Lost key replacement fee: \$50.

Pool Hours

- Hours are posted on the website and may change based on usage, staffing, and weather.
- The pool may close early if no members are present near closing time.
- Weather conditions may require closure.
- Hours may change when school resumes. The season may extend past Labor Day depending on conditions.



Pool Rules

1. No running on the pool deck
2. No rough play
3. No food, glass, or open drinks in the pool area
4. No profanity
5. Swim diapers required for young children
6. No flotation devices in the deep end
7. No diving in shallow areas
8. One person on the diving board at a time; clear the area after diving
9. Lifeguard stands are for lifeguards only
10. No prolonged underwater "dead man's float" when crowded
11. Exit pool during lightning; return after 30 minutes without thunder
12. Follow all lifeguard instructions
