

Insulation

Properly insulating your home is an important step to help lower your energy costs and create a comfortable home. You may be eligible for CleanBC rebates of up to 95% of the insulation upgrade costs. Adding insulation offers the following benefits:

Comfort

Make your home more comfortable year round.

Lower energy costs

Save money by reducing heat loss in the winter and heat gain in the summer.

Reduced noise

Make your home quieter by lessening outside noise entering your home.

^{*}Retrofit-enabling measures must be completed in association with an eligible insulation upgrade.

Rebate requirements overview

New insulation must be:

- Batt, loose fill, board or spray foam
- Installed by a registered contractor in accordance with the Best Practice Guide Air Sealing and Insulation Retrofits for Single Family Homes
- Installed to reduce heat loss from the home (e.g., insulation for soundproofing or insulation in outbuildings is not eligible)

Pest infestations and rodent tunnels in the location of the insulation must be resolved before upgrade.

Carefully read program requirements and terms and conditions to ensure eliqibility.

- 2. Pre-register online to receive an eligibility code. You can also make an appointment with an energy coach or schedule a virtual assessment for pre-registration assistance or support to identify the best upgrades for your home.
- **3.** Customer must choose a registered contractor to complete the upgrade.
- **4.** After completing the upgrade, contractor will submit the rebate application and deduct the rebate from the final cost of the upgrade.
