**Closing Date:** March 16, 2026 at 11:59 PM EDT or when entry limit of 149 is reached.

**Catalog is NO LONGER INCLUDED. A PAPER CATALOG can be purchased with entry.** AFTER THE SHOW CLOSES, each exhibitor will receive a link from the Entry Clerk for the show catalog. It is suggested you print the pages you will need (e.g. the pages that include your entries and the final pages). If you prefer to pay for a paper catalog, YOU MUST request it when you enter and pay the fee above.

**Entry Info:** Entry Fees include CFA & Regional surcharges. You are required to enter online. **Check your confirmation for accuracy and contact the entry clerk with corrections BEFORE THE CLOSING DATE.**

**No substitutions after the closing date.**

By entering exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and the show committee and to adhere to CFA show rules. CFA show rules are available online <http://cfa.org/resources>.

**Payment Info: Payment is required.** Per show rule 6.21 each entry must be accompanied by the stipulated entry fee. All entries must be paid in full within 10 days of receipt or prior to the start of the show, whichever is first. **NO REFUNDS AFTER YOUR ENTRY HAS BEEN CONFIRMED OR FOR FAILURE TO ATTEND THE SHOW.** Send payment Meowly Wow Wow Cat Club (MWWCC) c/o our entry clerk: **Cathy Dunham, 974 Lilly Rd. Alliance, OH 44601** Returned check fee is \$75 + all bank fees. *In order to expedite the check-in process please have exact cash at the door. A Square invoice will be emailed with confirmation and payment info.*

**Vetting:** It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, Calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must have all claws clipped prior to benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition.

**Household Pets:** All entries must be at least 4 months old; all entries 8 months or older must be neutered or spayed. Entries may not be declawed.

**Miscellaneous:** Show management will take reasonable care of cats and carriers but will not be responsible for damage or loss. Exhibitors are responsible for their own transportation. Clay litter will be provided. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food, and water/food dishes. This show will be advertising for spectators.

**Show Hall: Warren Count Fairgrounds, 665 North Broadway St., Lebanon, OH 45036.** People food by Let's Eat Food Truck. This is a smoke-free facility. The facility has A/C and heat as needed. Parking is free.

**Show Hours:** Check-in 7:30-8:30 AM Saturday; exhibitors of cats marked absent will need to check in with the clerk in each ring. Judging will start at 9 AM both days. Advertised show hours are 9 AM – 4 PM (or end of finals) both days.

**Benching:** Single cage size is approximate 22" x 22" x 22"; and is included with your entry. **Exhibitors with a single entry using any size security cage are required to purchase an extra 1/2 cage.** Bring cage curtains (or coverings) to cover the sides, top and bottom of cage. Litter will be provided, but not litter pans.

**Scoring:** All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.
