How do I know which program is the best for my daughter/son?

Travel Teams: These teams are for the intermediate to advance skill level player. Each athlete commits to attending all practices and all tournaments. Practices are designed to take players to “next level” of play. Playtime in tournaments is not guaranteed.

Regional "AAU" Teams : These are for the beginner players with 1-2 years of experience. Practices focus on building skills needed to play at more competitive level. Matches are designed to give all athletes a chance to test their skills

Mini Seasons: Clinic style practices for the beginner players to enhance skills and gain basic understanding of volleyball. Practices focus on building the fundamental skills needed to play the game.

2022-2023 Program Fee

Tuition covers facility rental and expenses, uniforms, coaching salaries and travel expense, tournament entry fees, administrative expenses and equipment.

The methods we use to assign players to teams are based on an evaluation conducted in a professional manner upon the consensus of qualified coaches. We evaluate all skills at tryouts and place athletes on teams based on their skill level. At SVC we strive to fill teams with a maximum of 10 athletes and no less than 8. Teams with more than 10 players can be formed with coaches and club directors' approval.

Our coaches are all background screened by USAV, AAU yearly.

Most of our staff are also school teachers or administrators in Sarasota and Manatee County schools.

All of our travel coaches have experience as players playing in their respective High schools, Colleges, Professional Leagues, etc and have at least 3 or more years of coaching experience.
