- **5. Confidentiality** Both parties agree to keep all valuation reports and related information confidential, except where disclosure is required by law.
- **6. Termination** This Agreement may be terminated by either party with a written notice of 30 days. The Client shall pay for all services rendered up to the termination date.
- **7. Governing Law** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the Provence of [Alberta, Saskatchewan], and any disputes shall be resolved in the courts of [Alberta, Saskatchewan].
