



Spay/Neuter Mobile Day For EL MIRAGE Residents

A \$35 non-refundable deposit is required when making your pet's appointment.

The deposit will cover post-surgery requirements.

FREE Spay/Neuter and Vaccines*

*Vaccinations for surgery patients only: Dogs- Rabies vaccine and Parvo/Distemper vaccine/ Cats: Rabies vaccine and FVRCP

The \$35 deposit will cover - post-surgery requirements of an E-collar & Post-surgery pain medication.

Veterinarian will administer either take-home medication or an injection given prior to discharge.

Brachycephalic breeds ("flat nose" pets) are NOT accepted at mobile events due to an increase risk of complications.

CLINIC RULES, RESTRICTIONS & REQUIREMENTS

Scheduling will open up to all MARICOPA COUNTY

- All pets must be in good health and friendly (able to be handled by staff)
- All pets must be brought in by legal owner, and at least 18 years old
- Puppies/kittens must weigh at least 3 lbs., and be at least 16 weeks of age
- **No pets over 55 lbs.** Pets will be weighed upon check-in and may be declined if over the limit.
- Pets must be between the ages of 4 months and 6 years; NO brachycephalic breeds ("flat nose" pets)
- All Dogs must be on a leash
- **Cats must be in a carrier (only one cat per carrier, please)**- This is for post-surgery recovery reasons.
- **A \$35 non-refundable deposit(per pet) is required at time of confirmation – when called back**
 - The scheduling team will call you from a (623) number. Due to the volume of callbacks- phone calls are limited, therefore, please have your credit card ready. Our partners - G.A.P.S. scheduling team, thanks you!
 - **Answers to scheduling questions concerning this event are available on the GreaterAZPets.org**
- This event and its funding is for owned pets (of the general public) and **not for use by breeders, rescue groups, pets in transition of homes, fosters, adopted pets from a rescue/shelter, strays and/or feral/stray/free-roaming cats.** FAS' efforts are to help those in need of financial assistance to provide a healthy life for their pets while preventing future accidental litters and unwanted pets entering our shelter system. 2 pets per household/owner, per 12-month period, through FAS funding.
