A Regular meeting of Summer Village Council was called to order at 6:07 PM on Tuesday, December 9, 2025.

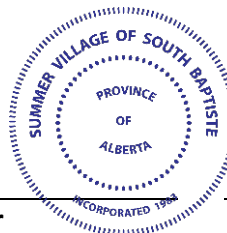
