Scalp Micropigmentation is done with small dots of pigment implanted into the skin with a very thin needle on a tattoo machine. The dots are the exact same size as the hair follicle making it nearly impossible to tell the difference between the real hair and the SMP. In this course, we will discuss the benefits of this revolutionary procedure, the anatomy of the skin, contraindications that would make the procedure difficult, and proper technique. The course concludes with a dive into marketing, branding, and business practices.

## FACILITY RULES

- Each student must conduct themselves in an honorable and ethical manner, showing professionalism, dignity & respect for your fellow students, instructors, all clients & models.
- Using your phone on the floor (work area), when taking before and after photos of your clients/models is allowed. Otherwise, phones are to remain in your pocket or in the classroom area.
- Phones are not to be used during class. Calls may be taken outside the studio, on your own time, such as during lunch/breaks. We get permission from our clients and models for our students to "observe the process." Therefore, it is important that the students always allow the instructors and students focus on their clients while they are working. There is to be no unnecessary talking to, or near the instructors/students while they are working. If you have a question or absolutely have to say something - you may ask quietly. Otherwise, write down your questions to be asked after the procedure is completed.
- You may take two 15 minute breaks and one 30 minute lunch break. You can bring your own lunch or dine out.
- Be mindful of others and keep the kitchen and classroom clean at all times;
- anything left out will be thrown away, daily. We only allow the models & students in the procedure areas during class time. We do not allow friends or family members in the procedure areas. Please ask your friends/family to meet you in the reception area or in outside the studio for breaks or after class. You are allowed to have no more than one model on "model day." Models will either have previous work requiring a touch up or require new services. Which type of model you will receive cannot be guaranteed. After you complete your procedure on your model, you will receive a certificate, per whichever course was completed.
- After graduation, you are allowed to bring in clients into our studio. The first three chair rentals are free, and after the third, there is a fee of \$100 to rent a chair. The fee is the same regardless of if the procedure is a touch up or first time.

**Please, always respect instructors time & classroom time.**

**There is a zero-tolerance policy in the use of recreational or medical drugs, alcohol, or any other substance that can impair or endanger yourself or any other person.**

## CANCELLATION POLICY

If you wish to cancel or reschedule your course, you must provide a written notice to [permanentmakeupplus@gmail.com](mailto:permanentmakeupplus@gmail.com) at least 7 days before the start date of your course. If you sign up for a course within the 7 day period, you are still subject to the same cancellation policy. If a written notice is not provided within those 7 days, we will refund the course amount minus a deposit of \$500. If you wish to cancel or reschedule your course after the course has begun, your entire course price will be forfeited.

## STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

You have the right to cancel your agreement for a program of instruction, without any penalty or obligations, through attendance at the first class session or the seventh calendar day after enrollment, whichever is later. After the end of the cancellation period, you also have the right to stop school at any time; and you have the right to receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 60 percent or less of the scheduled days/hours in the current payment period in your program through the last day of attendance. Cancellation may occur when the student provides a written notice of cancellation at the following address: 1399 Ygnacio Valley RD, Suite 36, Walnut Creek, CA 94598. This can be done by mail or by hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail properly addressed with proper postage. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and however expressed; it is effective if it shows that the student no longer wishes to be bound by the Enrollment Agreement. If the Enrollment Agreement is canceled before the course starts, the school will refund the student any money he/she paid, less a registration or administration fee not to exceed \$250.00, and less any deduction for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days after the notice of cancellation is received.

## OUT OF TOWN STUDENTS

North California has a high cost of living. Expected non institutional costs for students who do not live within commuting distance should be expected. Housing can cost between \$100-\$400 per night depending on individual preference and local availability, and the IRS estimates per diem for meals and incidentals to cost \$66 in Walnut Creek. Students should add housing and per diem costs based on the number of days for their chosen programs, in addition to the one cost of health department registration, bloodborne pathogen certificate, and total program cost to have an estimate of total charges for the estimated total charges for their period of attendance.

## WITHDRAWAL FROM THE PROGRAM

You may withdraw from the school at any time after the cancellation period and receive a pro rata refund if you have completed 40% or less of the scheduled days/hours in the current payment period in your program through the last day of attendance. The refund will be less than the registration or administration fee, not to exceed \$250.00, unless there are any deductions for equipment not returned in good condition, within 45 days of withdrawal. If the student has completed more than 60% of the period of attendance for which the student was charged, the tuition is considered earned and the student will receive no refund. For the purpose of determining a refund under this section, a student shall be deemed to have withdrawn from a program of instruction when any of the following occurs:

\*The student notifies the institution of the student's withdrawal, or as of the date of the student's withdrawal, whichever is later.

\*The institution terminates the student's enrollment for failure to maintain satisfactory progress; failure to abide by the rules and regulations of the institution; absences in excess of maximum set forth by the institution; and/or failure to meet financial obligations to the School.

\*The student fails to return from a leave of absence.

For the purpose of determining the amount of the refund, the date of the student's withdrawal shall be deemed the last date of recorded attendance. The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, minus non-refundable fees, divided by the number of days/hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days/hours scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.
