

Town of Saxeville Land Use Planning Committee Meeting February 5th, 2026

Location: Saxeville Springwater Fire Department meeting room

The meeting was called to order at 4:02 PM

A motion to approve the meeting agenda was made by Paul Roemer, seconded by Evan Terry, the committee voted all in favor.

A motion to approve the December meeting minutes was made by Leah Hanen, seconded by Evan Terry, the committee voted all in favor.

Public comment was given by Rick Schaber, Mike Berg, Wendy Vincent, Cindy Bolovsky, Britt Mason, and Thomas Catlin all regarding enhanced wake on Long Lake.

***It was noted that this committee is not in charge of making any decision regarding enhanced wake rules on Long Lake but will consider their comments if anything in our plan comes up around that topic. ***

Tim presented the land use survey data and handed out maps showing the current land use plans. He also handed out a packet containing the comments from the open-ended questions of the survey. We received around 120 responses. Tim presented "heat maps" of certain data points. The committee would like Tim to pull the age demographics of the people that completed the survey; Tim will get that information and email it out.

A motion to provide the power point data that was presented today on the Town of Saxeville website was made by Evan Terry, seconded by Paul Roemer, the committee voted all in favor.

Tom Catlin requested to have paper copies of that information due to being computer illiterate. Janine will work something out with him.

Members will review the information given out today and come in with new goals for the March meeting.

The committee will not be discussing Long Lake enhanced wake issue until we get to a point in the plan that deal with lakes specifically. Bart Peterson noted that this was only brought here today in hopes of using some of the data gathered from our current survey. The public in

attendance would like us to review the data from Springwater's Long Lake survey as well, Janine will get that information from Rick Schaber at a later date.
