

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020 – 12-21.2**

**Town of Saxeville  
Waushara County, Wisconsin**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF COMPRESSION  
BRAKES IN THE TOWN OF SAXEVILLE**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board of the Town of Saxeville, Waushara County, Wisconsin, has received, either directly or through the Sheriff's Department, numerous complaints about the use of compression brakes in the Town of Saxeville;

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board finds that the use of motor vehicle brakes which are activated or operated by the compression of the engine of a motor vehicle disturbs and disrupts the public peace and quiet;

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board believes it is in the best interest of public health, safety and general welfare to prohibit the use of compression brakes within the town limits of the Town of Saxeville;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Saxeville does ordain as follows:

**SECTION I – COMPRESSION BRAKES PROHIBITED**

No person shall use motor vehicle brakes which are in any way activated or operated by the compression of the engine of any such motor vehicle or any unit or part thereof within the town limits of the Town of Saxeville.

**SECTION II – VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES**

Violations of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$1,000.00 for each instance of noncompliance together with court costs and the costs of prosecution.

**SECTION III – EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall take effect the day after passage and publication as provided by law.
